Accommodations Arriving by Boat

Recommended Hotel Accommodations

For the GLCC members who need local lodging, a block of rooms have been set aside at the Four Points by Sheraton:

Four Points Harborside at a special low rate of \$199 USD/night. Simply call the hotel directly at 941-637-6770, and use Group Code GLCC. Spring Break is in the middle of peak season in Florida. Please note that in order to obtain this low rate, your reservations must be made by January 10. The 106-room hotel is located on the edge of the Charlotte Harbor. From there, you can easily explore the unique shops and restaurants, which line the cobblestone streets of Punta Gorda's newly revitalized downtown.
