Seeking some bays to explore?



These 5 chain links represent the 5 Great Lakes and this burgee signals that the boat owners are members of the Great Lakes Cruising Club (GLCC). These boaters are often explorers of at least Georgian Bay and the North Channel, and even the waters beyond "The Bay". If you are seeking the very best cruising information regarding the 30,000 Islands and beyond, you really should consider joining the Great Lakes Cruising Club.

The GLCC is a volunteer organization of friendly, serious boaters who like to explore all or part of the five Great Lakes. These lakes provide some of the best fresh water boating in the world and we have this amazing opportunity to explore just beyond the boundaries of our marina. With a membership of 2,500 boaters from at least 400 harbours and marinas in the 5 Great Lakes, the GLCC has earned the reputation of being the authoritative voice of "local cruising knowledge" for the Great Lakes. The membership consists of Canadians and Americans who are either sailors or power boaters, thus giving the organization an impressive blend of cruising and boating knowledge. New members are always warmly welcomed!

The GLCC was formed in 1934 and its core purpose, consistently since those early days, has been to share its members' love of the Great Lakes and to provide accurate and timely cruising information to all its membership. Over the years, GLCC members have prepared over 1,100 Harbour Reports which provide an unparalleled collection of information regarding harbours and both popular and remote anchorages. These harbour reports, which contain detailed written summaries complemented by accurate charted information, are regularly updated by members.



The numerous Harbour Reports for the 30,000 Islands and the North Channel are of excellent quality and will get you off to a great start exploring the outstanding anchorages right in our "back yard". All Harbour Reports are available to members on-line at www.glcclub.com - they can be viewed on-line, or printed or stored on your computer for future use. Interestingly, there still remain some remote anchorages in Georgian Bay and Lake Superior where published government charts do not provide the level of detail required when seeking safe anchorages. GLCC Harbour Reports often provide the best information for these remote anchorages.

In addition to the Harbour Reports, the GLCC offers excellent on-line webinars on a variety of topics and often there are Port Captains available around the Great Lakes who volunteer their time to provide local knowledge and assistance

to GLCC members.

This year, from June 24 to June 26, there will be a Georgian Bay Rally at the Cedar Springs area of Beausoleil to which all GLCC members in this area of Georgian Bay are invited. This will be an excellent opportunity to meet some GLCC members and to learn a more about the GLCC. Please consider joining the GLCC and attending this rally.

On the home page you will find a "Learn More" button regarding The Great Lakes Cruising Club. 


Well here it is the last day of February and I am writing my update once again.



Little Current Yacht Club's Cruisers' Net

If you are preparing to cruise the North Channel this year take notice and keep your VHF tuned in every morning to VHF Channel 71 at 9:00 AM for the Little Current Yacht Club's Cruisers' Net. Roy Eaton, retired high school principal and founding Commodore of the Little Current Yacht Club is up every morning at 5:00 a.m. writing his script for the broadcast. Each broadcast begins with the now familiar words: "It's 9 AM. Welcome Boaters to the Cruisers' Net." After which he asks, "First, is there any emergency, medical or priority traffic?"

This opening is a welcome voice to the community of cruisers who sometimes do have

emergencies that require help. To date, Roy has assisted boaters with bad engines, broken limbs, lost gear, transportation home, and messages from loved ones with news from family deaths to births. Roy even arranged for a minister for a couple to be married aboard their sailboat in the bay by his house.

His broadcast is usually heard by boaters up to 30 miles away, as his antenna sits on a tower atop the Anchor Inn, 110 feet above the North Channel waters. Thus, the transmission covers approximately 50 miles of North Channel waters and the northern section of Georgian Bay.

The Anchor Inn has let him use their conference room,

which he has slowly taken over with club burgees from places as far away as Australia left by thankful boaters. Some days, he may have as many as 30 visitors listening to the live broadcast in the conference room, chatting, and making new friends.

The program consists of the latest weather predictions for the North Channel, news of the world, sports scores, business reports, local news and happenings of interest to boaters as they cruise the North Channel. The second half of the broadcast allows boaters to check-in with their name and location, receive assistance or advice, have questions

answered and do relays between distant parts of our cruising grounds. In 2015, there were 6,312 calls received from 887 individual boats.

The public is invited to attend a morning's broadcast in the 2nd floor conference room of the Anchor Inn. Every Friday, from 3:00-5:00 pm the Cruisers' Net and the Anchor Inn invite boaters to enjoy a fellowship time in the bar area of the hotel. Complimentary hor d'oeuvers are provided by the Anchor Inn staff.






Lexie Richards Shift Leader & Dockhand

In an effort to have more community presence and give back to those in need, South Bay Cove Yacht Haven has partnered with a charity called Boaters for Best Care (526give.ca/boatersforbestcare) that is run by the folks at Georgian Bay General Hospital.

GBGH is located in the town of Midland, and is the only property in the southern Georgian Bay area to care for our sick and injured.

With new federal and provincial legislation, hospitals that provide more services, receive more government funding and smaller facilities that offer less, such as GBGH are greatly impacted by these budget cuts.

Because the hospital has spent a great deal of their money repairing the walls of the building that were in great disrepair, investment for new treatments, procedures, equipment and services have fallen by the waste side. GBGH is seeking funding from the community to purchase new equipment that are pertinent to keeping their doors open (ie CT/MRI, Obstetrics, cardiology and ER equipment). If they cannot raise enough funds to get where they need to be financially, the hospital will

close and the closest medical care in our area will be Orillia or Barrie

The reason we have taken an interest in this charity is due to the fact that it affects our clients, families and businesses. For any emergencies in our area, the first stop for the ill is GBGH. If GBGH cannot handle the ailment, transportation to a city centre property is the next step. Regardless of whether we want to admit it or not, illness and injury are inevitable and while we hope they don't strike when we are on vacation, things happen.

What we have offered GBGH is a facility to host a summer fundraising dinner to help support their charity. As I am sure many of us will understand how worthy this cause is, we have decided to combine it with our "Welcome Home" party on Saturday June 11, 2016.
