Whitehall Landing is on same side as Municipal marina and has a pool (231-894-5622).

Ellenwood Landing Marina has a pool and is a 5-10 minute walk from the Municipal Marina (231-893-9663).

**OVERNIGHT TRAILER PARKING** is not permitted at city parks/launches, HOWEVER, parking is available at the White Lake Area Chamber of Commerce, 124 W. Hanson St in Whitehall. Advance notice if trailers/vehicles will be parked there overnight is needed so police can be informed. (The Chamber is located on Colby Street across from Goodrich Park).

In Montague, located south of the stop light on Water Street past the marina and Band Shell, (signs are posted for launch ramp), the ramp has three docks serving six launch slips.
