Segment 5: Post Rendezvous: Exploring up to Thunder Bay and Isle Royale

- Isle Royale: Washington Harbor ([S-163](#))
- McCargoe Cove ([S-159](#))
- Rock Harbor Area ([S-173 to S-180.5](#))
